1 Student Financial Aid Office (SFAO)

For smooth implementation of scholarship programs, a separate Student Financial Aid Office (SFAO) was established in Government College University, Faisalabad in collaboration with Higher Education Commission, Islamabad in 2007.

GOOD HEALTH & WELL-BEING


Various activities performed at Government College University Faisalabad for addressing the SDG 3 are summarized as follows.

1 Courses

The Department of Zoology at GCUF has faculty with expertise in Fisheries and Aquaculture. Department of Zoology is offering subjects in the fields of fisheries, aquaculture, Aquatic toxicology, marine science, post-harvest handling of fish and fish processing technology for BS, MPhil and PhD students. The knowledge acquired from these courses prepares the students for employment in commercial aquaculture, aquaculture extension, fish hatchery management, natural resource management, environmental impact assessment and sustainable development.

2 Research

The Department of Zoology actively partakes in research on water conservation, sustainability, aquaculture challenges, and marine debris prevention constantly working to enhance its processes and inspire others in the sector.

3 Awareness campaigns

In addition, the Department is keen on conducting awareness campaigns to educate the community about water conservation, reduce marine pollution, ocean acidification, harvesting, overfishing illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing, thus, contributing to a culture of sustainability.

Awareness campaigns are also conducted on the effects of plastic on the seas and oceans as usage and wrong disposal of plastic is a major cause of marine pollution.

As the Department of Zoology stride towards achieving goal of saving life below water, we continue to explore new opportunities for innovation, collaboration, and education in the field of water management and sustainability.
